

## **GSA/DLA Conference Call on Federal Surplus Personal Property Program**

September 23, 2015

- Mark Brantley opened up the meeting at approximately 12:30 pm. Mark told the states that the budget has not been agreed upon for FY 2016. Unless they do by the end of the month, there will be a shut down of government by October 1<sup>st</sup>. This will impact GSA and the Donation Program. All staff will be sent home or only for emergency purposes. This is significant. Normal allocations of property will be halted. If it does happen and property is already allocated, contact the agency for removal and pick up. DLA and GSA notified NASASP is that both systems will coordinate and everything will be pushed back week by week so that everything will still be there when the government opens up.
- DLA – Dave Neill – Issue from Forth Worth. Item names being updated, 3000 NIINs done, another 4000 coming. Hopefully DLA items in GSAXcess will have names as soon as the system is updated. Prices on all items have also been fixed and should be better in the future, along with the locations in the system. DLA has made a change with GSA for items reported after October 1<sup>st</sup> to include locations. Also, other changes include cancellations in the system, the items should be restarted, but you will not be reallocated the item, the first allocation will hold. Problems of items being released without a proper SF 122s and SF 123s should not be an issue.
- Arkansas – We would like to comment on the DLA team. Things are going very well for the states, with all of the system changes being made and also customer service.
- Georgia – Concerns about GSA's policy on humvees. NASASP is having a problems with putting all of the restrictions on the items for the SASPs, but not for Sales Customers. Who do we need to talk to about these restrictions and getting them changed. Why can't we get these items to other donees.
- DLA – Sherry Low – the White House Working Group, made the humvees controlled items.
